## Councilmember Scherman Holds Community Breakfast City Officials to Discuss Foreclosure Impacts on Elk Grove

This month's breakfast is one of a series of housing and economy related forums Councilmember Scherman will be hosting over the next several months including workshops for families trying to prevent foreclosures and bankruptcies.
