ELK GROVE - On **Tuesday, July 8, 2008 at 7:30 A.M.**, Councilmember Sophia Scherman will host her monthly **community breakfast** to discuss the foreclosure crisis and Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's plan to fight the growing number of foreclosures in Elk Grove. Secretary of the State and Consumer Services Agency **Rosario Marin** will be on hand to discuss California's economy, the foreclosure crisis, and small business procurement - issues that are a top concern for Elk Grove residents.

In addition to her roll with the administration, Secretary Marin also served as the 41st Treasurer of the United States. A position, which gives her a unique insight into today's struggling economy.

This month's breakfast is second of a series of housing and economy related forums Councilmember Scherman is hosting. The first breakfast included a discussion of

### Elk Grove City Councilmember Sophia Scherman Voted Unanimously to Help Lead the California State Parks and Recreation Commission

ELK GROVE -- On May 17, 2008 Sophia Scherman was voted unanimously to replace Oscar-winning actor Clint Eastwood's vacancy as the Vice Chair of the California States Parks and Recreation Commission.

"Vibrant parks for our families are my passion," commented Councilmember Scherman. "It is my priority to make sure our communities maintain parks in wake of a state budget shortfall."

"Neglecting our parks cost taxpayers more in the long run - running up deferred maintenance costs. As the legislature tightens its belt on frivolous spending, I'll fight to ensure our parks are not shortchanged."

Councilmember Sophia Scherman was first appointed to the State Parks and Recreation Commission in 2004 and

served with notable members such as Clint Eastwood and Bobby Shriver, until they came off the commission earlier this year.
